Gas & foam history

1917

The company of Holger Nielsen & Co. is founded (agency and wholesale company)

1970

The fire extinguishing department is separated from the parent company under the name of "A/S Ginge-Brand og Elektronik"

1994

Ginge-Kerr is taken over by "Unitor".

2006

Danfoss takes over 60% of the Semco Maritime fire fighting division and a new company is established: "Danfoss Semco A/S Fire Protection".

1955

The company is turned into a limited company called "A/S Holger Nielsen & Co". In the same year a special department for fire extinguishing is established

1988

Ginge takes over John Kerr, England, and the name is changed to "Ginge-Kerr"

1999

"Semco Maritime" employs the major part of the group of employees from Unitor's production company, "Marine Fire Protection".
